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THE CARIYÂ-PIȚAKA.

THE Cariyâ-Pițaka, one of the fifteen books of the *Khuddaka*nikâya, is a series of metrical tales of Gotama-Buddha in previous states of existence. They set forth briefly the lofty means (the *dasa pâramiyo*) by which he attained to the Buddhahood.

The thirty-five stories in this poetical compilation are all Jâtaka-tales, and are based upon similar narratives in the Pâli Jâtaka-book. In fact, these "birth-stories" presuppose a familiar acquaintance with all the incidents of the corresponding prose tales, so that the mere mention of the Kapirâja or Sacca birth would serve to recall to the mind of the hearer or reader all the chief incidents of the well-known Jâtaka-tale, much in the same way as the simple allusion to one of the New Testament parables (the Good Samaritan or the Prodigal Son) would be thoroughly understood without any further reference to the main points of the narrative. We are not therefore surprised to find that the metrical Jâtakas are much shorter than the prose tales (compare the Kurudhamma-cariyam and its eight verses with the Jâtaka No. 276).

In the former version, moreover, the writer was chiefly concerned in bringing out the moral element, and he consequently leaves out of view the humour, fun, and even moral of the older stories (compare the *Mahimsarâjacariyam* with Jâtaka No. 275).

One story (Book III. viii. p. 97), consisting only of a single verse, omits all details, so that we have only the bare statement that Buddha in a former birth, by his truth, preserved the world. This brevity makes it somewhat

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difficult to harmonize the two versions of these old birthstories.

In the Kapirdjacariyam (III. vii. p. 97) the incidents are so few that one is not enabled to state whether this story be the same as the amusing Sumsumara-jataka (?=Vânarajâtaka, No. 342), No. 208, or not.

Two stories, III. ix. p. 98 (Jat. No. 35) and III. x. p. 99 (Jåt. No. 75) contain verses from the Jåtaka-book. The quotation in the Carivâ-Pitaka (line 11, p. 98) supplies a reading which sets right the faulty metre of the printed text (see Prof. Fausböll's Jâtaka, i. p. 215).

Ten of the stories in the present work may be compared with corresponding birth-tales in Dr. Fausböll's edition of the Jâtakas :---

With the aid of Westergaard's Codices Orientales Bibliothecæ Regiæ Harniensis (pp. 36-42), we see that nearly all the other stories of the Cariyâ-Pitaka, inaccessible as yet in print, have their originals in the Jâtaka-book, and may be here briefly given under the Nipâta, where they are found.

Sankha, Cûlabodhi, and Kanha-Dîpâyana belong to the Dasanipâta ; Yudhañjaya to the Ekâdasanipâta ; Akatti and Rururâja (=Rurumiga) are in the Terasanipâta; Sivi,² Campeyya, Mâtanga, Somanassa, Ayoghara, Bhisa, and Sacca

form part of the Visatinipata; Javaddisa belongs to the Sankhapâla to the Cattâlisanipâta; Timsanivâta : Sona (=Sonananda) to the Sattatinipâta; Nimirâja,¹ Vessantara,² Bhûridatta, Temiya (=Mûgapakkha), Sutasoma (=Mahâsutasoma?), and Suvanna sâma (=Sâma) are in the last series, the Asitinipata.

I have failed, however, to trace the following three stories to their source :---1. Mahagovinda. 2. Dhammadhamma (=Mittâmittajâtaka in the Dvâdasanipata?). 3. Candakumâra.³

The Cariyâ-Pițaka is divided into three parts. The first book treats of DANAPARAMITA,⁴ and is illustrated by ten stories; the second has also ten stories in illustration of Sîlapâramitâ; the third and last part deals with other sections of the Dasa pâramiyo as follows :- The first five stories refer to pariccâga, and serve to illustrate NEKKHAMMA-PÂRAMITĂ. The PÂRAMITÂS of pañnâ, viriyam, and khanti are entirely passed over unnoticed, though the writer could not fail to find some suitable stories with reference to these "perfections" in the Jâtaka-book.

ADHITTHÂNA-PÁRAMITÂ has only one story devoted to it (No. VI.); SACCAPÂRAMITÂ is illustrated by six stories (Nos. VII.-XII.); METTÂPÂRAMITÂ by two (Nos. XIII. and XIV.); and UPEKHÂPÂRAMITÂ by one (No. XV.).

To a certain extent paññâ, viriyam, khanti, adhitthânam, and upekhâ are involved in the other pâramitas, and this perhaps may account for the omission of the first three, and the slight treatment of the last two perfections.⁵

The author of the Cariyâ-Pițaka probably intended to devote an equal number of stories to each of the Dasapâramiyo; and had he done so, then we should have possessed ten books containing one hundred stories.

The JATAKA-MALA contains thirty-five birth-stories, ten of which have titles identical with the Carivâ-Pitaka tales.¹

In the MAHÂVASTU we find the Kapirâjacariyam under the title of "the story of the Porpoise" (=the Sumsumâraiâtaka), as well as the Vânarajâtaka and Mahâgovindacariyam.

The BHADRAKALPA-AVADÂNA contains the stories of Silavanába and Sutasoma.

The BODHISATTVA-AVADÂNA relates the Sivi, Sasa, Matsya, Vattapotaka, Ruru and Sutasoma birth-stories.

It also has the Buddhabodhijataka, which resembles the Cûlabodhicariyam of the Cariyâ-Pițaka.²

As far as regards the grammatical peculiarities, there is not much to be said. Professor Fausböll has already pointed out, in his "Introduction to the Sutta-Nipâta" (pp. xii, xiii), the forms, grammatical and lexicographical, common to Pâli poetry. The Cariyâ-Pitaka seems to have more of such peculiarities than the Buddhavamsa. The phrase Kusale dasah' upâgato (I. ii. l. 1, p. 74) Dr. Oldenberg has already noticed in Zeitschrift für vergl. Sprachf. N. F. v. 3, p. 320. He also refers to Buddhavamsa, II. l. 32, p. 8.3

We sometimes find the preposition more or less movable, as (in II. 4, l. 9, p. 86) vuddhitum pari (=parivuddhitum). More curious still are ajjha so vasi (p. 64, l. 5) and ajjha 'ham casim (p. 65, l. 14), in which the prefix and augment are separated from the verb. The form kydham (l. 9, p. 87) = ke +aham, where ke has the force of kim or kena, cf. tayidam= te-idam, where te=tad or tam; ye for yad or yam is not uncommon. These may be locatives used adverbially, but see Dr. Trenckner's Pâli Miscellany, p. 75.

In this edition of the Cariyâ-Pițaka, I have mainly followed the Additional MSS. 935, 936, in the University Library, Cambridge, written on paper in Sinhalese characters. No. 935 contains the text, copied from a good MS. in the wihâra at

as we find tumhe for tumhehi (Jât. i. p. 124).

Galle. No. 936 has no text, but presents all the variant readings of four manuscripts belonging to Degalla and Dadalla wiharas.¹

Of these MSS. two (one from Dadalla, and the other from Degalla) are in Sinhalese writing. The other two are Burmese MSS., and on these Dr. Rhys Davids has made the following note on a fly-leaf of the transcript, No. 936 :---

"The Burmese book and Burmese commentary are not by the same hand, but apparently of about equal age. They were brought to Dadalla wihare by Bopâgoda Unnanse, the Nâyaka Unnanse of the Amarâpura sect, who went to Burma about fifty years ago and there received Upasampadâ. He died about five years ago. His most distinguished pupil is Lankâgoda Unnanse, of Dewetagoda Wihara in Colombo.

"The other two books are each about thirty years old. (Galle, Nov. 3rd, 1869.)"

I have, also, carefully collated these with the Phayre MS. in the India Office Library. I have not had the advantage of any commentary, but expect shortly to have one from Ceylon. Part II. will contain various readings and extracts from the Commentary.

I here take the opportunity of acknowledging the kindness of Dr. Rost and Mr. Henry Bradshaw for the loan of valuable MSS. from their respective libraries. My best thanks are due to Dr. Frankfurter for collating my transcript of the Buddhavamsa with the Wilson MS. at Oxford, and to my friend Dr. Rhys Davids (who has drawn me away from my old love) for many valuable suggestions from time to time, and for the interest he has at all times taken in these humble efforts of mine to do something towards augmenting the number of Pâli Texts.
